'09-'10 Open Enrollment

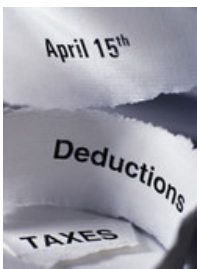
We will need parent drivers for this trip.
