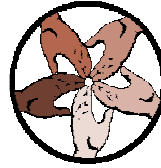

EVENTS TO TAKE NOTE OF IN MAY 2009:

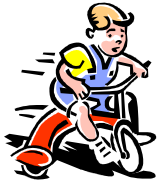
May 8, 2009: Minimum Day. School ends at 12:00 pm. No daycare.
