Primary Training Course Summary

This Primary course is a two-year, part-time course which prepares adults to teach children, between the ages of 2 ½ and 6, in a Montessori environment. It is designed to be an interactive study based on Montessori's vision for lifelong learning, utilizing all her materials and methodologies, integrated with current research in child development and early childhood education. The course includes instruction in the following areas:

- The Exercises of Practical Life
- The Sensorial Materials
- The Cultural Subjects
- Peace Education
- Language Development
- Mathematics
- Child Psychology & Development –
Montessori's Approach (The Formation of Man)
- Montessori's Philosophy of Education -
Cosmic Education
- Classroom Management
- Observation Techniques

A year-long supervised internship in a Montessori classroom is required. A Certificate of Completion is issued upon successful completion of the course.



Admission Procedure

A bachelor's degree is preferred, but not essential. To apply, please provide:

- A completed application
- A non-refundable application fee of \$50
- A letter of intent, outlining the reasons why training is desired
- Three letters of recommendation from individuals with which the prospective student has a professional relationship.
- Copies of official transcripts from his/her former college or university.

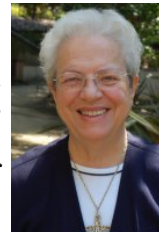
