If you are accepted into the program, you will be sent a letter of acceptance and a financial contract. To complete your enrollment in the program, you need to return the financial contract to us with the first tuition installment. In the instance that you are not accepted into the program, you will be notified by the Director. Please do not let the amount of tuition keep you from pursuing your Montessori Certification. We would be happy to discuss your needs and create a payment plan that works for you.
